The children will study the sea-scapes of Van Gogh

We will make careful observational drawings of shells and make prints of fish.

We will make boats from re-cycled plastic objects.

Geography

We will study the different ocean and seas of the world.

We will visit the sea-side.

English

We will begin with writing a recount about our visit to Plymouth aquarium.

We will learn about hump back whales and read non-fiction books. We will read 'the Snail and the Whale' and learn how to write postcards and letters.

We have a daily phonics lesson and will be practise our letter sounds and spelling of key words. In reception we will learn and begin to use capital letters. We will begin to join our writing.

The children will also have daily handwriting practise.

We will use the internet to find facts about humpback whales and learn how to print pictures.
