

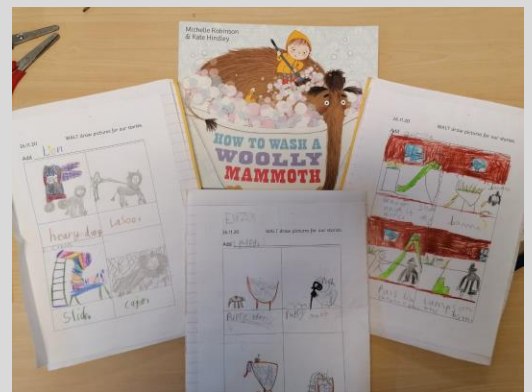
Class R

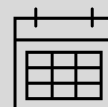
