The children all had a lovely time on Monday for their visit to RHS Rosemoor. Class 1 helped Rosie to become a real garden fairy. They ventured into the garden armed with a bucket and an ingredients list to collect as many seasonal things as they could find. On their return Rosie set the task of making seasonal crowns for the children to take home.



In Class 2's workshop they learnt how to identify, measure the height, record features and how a tree works. In groups , the children were given equipment and instructions on recording a wide variety of information about their tree including height, bark, leaf, twigs and girth.

Class 3 Investigated the appearance and properties of different kinds of rocks and found out how they contribute to soil. They used universal indicator in test tubes, mixed with different soils to show how acidic or alkaline each soil was. They compared the colours to the ph scale to find out.
