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Class R

We have been very busy at home and at school this half term. We have been enjoying traditional tales in literacy and have drawn story maps, retold the stories, made finger puppets and written sentences. We made bridges for the Billy Goats Gruff and houses for The Three Little Pigs.

In school the children have enjoyed their PE sessions. Comments included, "I played hockey outside. I like it.", "we played skittles. You have to knock cones down" and "My favourite bit was the obstacle course". At home children have been riding their bikes, going on woodland walks and following Joe Wicks. One child even created an in -door pretend swimming pool, complete with lifeguard!






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Class 1
































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






























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
Class 2
















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Mealtime Assistant Vacancy
