


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This week Ellie and Bobby brought in one of their lambs to show to each class. The pupils all had a chance to hold, stroke and ask questions about her.

On Evacuation Day, firstly we had to take a register so that we knew all evacuees were present. We had to bring in a suitcase or a box with a brush, toothbrush, a book, a bar of soap, a toy and some photos and food parcels. We also had previously made luggage tags and ration books. On our daily mile, we pretended that we were walking to the train station to leave for the countryside which would have taken seven hours!

I really liked going to school and it being different. I would have felt really scared and worried as an evacuee.
