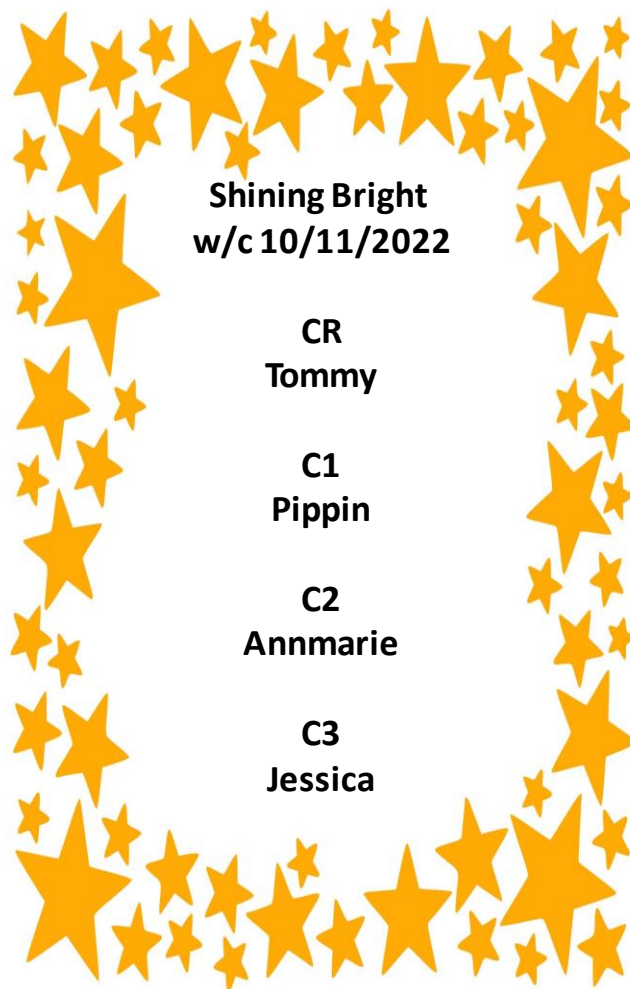
## Help wanted!
