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Safter Internet Day

Reception

In Reception we learnt about Smartie The Penguin. He had been given a new tablet for his birthday and was very excited. We read the story and found out how he learns to be safe on the internet.

Class 1

We have been talking about being safe on the internet this week as part of Safer Internet day on Tuesday 7th February. We discussed ways to keep yourself safe on the internet and talked about not putting your name, school or contact details online. We learnt that anybody could post things on the internet and therefore we need to consider the reliability of the information we find on the internet. The children learnt that no one owns the internet, and no one decides what can be put on; the internet can be used by everyone, and everyone can add things to it! The children also thought about safe apps and websites for children to use.

Class 2

Class 2 had some brilliant discussions around staying safe on the internet and all the different ways we can use the internet.

Class 2's top tips for staying safe online are

- Don't share personal information online
- Don't talk to strangers online

• If you see something that upsets you, go and tell an adult that you trust

We watched the online safety video on BBC teach. We had lots of discussions about being safe online and followed the advice.
